It is fairly short notice, but I want to call your attention to the refurbished S.J. Quinney Ph.D. Fellowship program. We will be offering up to 5 competitive fellowships. The brochure can be found at:

These 4-year fellowships provide \$20,000 per year in stipend, \$12,000 per year in tuition, and a research budget. The successful "Fellows" will generally be associated with one of the projects noted on the brochure, but will have considerable freedom to develop an independent research project within the Great Salt Lake Watershed (which is quite large and contains a great variety of habitats). Fellows can also be associated with the Ecology Center. In some cases it might be possible to associate with another faculty member in CNR (other than those with projects on the list), so if you are very excited about working with someone else in the College, do not hesitate to contact them.

I would like to call especial attention to my own project on Ecological Restoration and Weed Ecology in the Great Basin, primarily because the final version of the brochure has dropped my name from the project. I'm working on that.
