DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Position is located in the Range and Meadow Forage Management Research unit in Eastern Oregon. The research consists of a series of greenhouse and field studies designed to achieve the following objectives: 1) compare life-histories and competitive abilities of native species and cheatgrass along a nutrient gradient, and 2) determine the influence of cover crop, burning, and plant litter on soil nutrient availability.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: 1) Recent Ph.D. in ecology, range science or related field, 2) field research experience in ecology or wildland weed science, and 3) ability to utilize research techniques for plant competition and nutrient cycling studies.
