GENERAL INFORMATION

The Department of State Lands (DSL) is recruiting for two (2) full-time, seasonal positions, for the period of May through October 2006. Both positions are in Bend, Oregon. This recruitment will be used to develop a list of qualified people to fill the vacant positions and may be used to fill future vacancies.

TO QUALIFY

You must have:

- \* A Bachelor's degree in Natural Resource Management or
- \* Three years of experience performing rangeland assessments.

IF YOU QUALIFY

There is no test for this announcement. If you meet the "To Qualify" requirements on this announcement, your name will be placed on the list with a code of "QLF" (Qualified) and you will be contacted for an interview.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The purpose of this position is to assist the agency in performing rangeland health assessment inventories on state owned rangelands. Duties include collection of vegetation data, inventorying and documenting improvements. Other duties include monitoring, utilization, compliance and mapping of rangelands.

WORKING CONDITIONS

Work will be in remote locations, alone and requires overnight travel. Work hours are irregular and sometimes long. Visits to on-site locations may be by vehicle, watercraft or on foot. Site visits often involve walking over uneven terrain and in wet muddy ground without pathways in all types of weather.

Complete all parts of the application.
