The objectives of the third annual Research Insights in Semiarid Ecosystems (RISE) Symposium are to share recent results of scientific research at the USDA-ARS Walnut Gulch Experimental Watershed (WGEW) and the University of Arizona Santa Rita Experimental Range (SRER), to encourage future research activities at the WGEW and the SRER, and to promote the WGEW and the SRER as outdoor scientific laboratories.

The Symposium will feature invited speakers presenting recent research on the WGEW, SRER or other outdoor laboratories. There will be time for questions from the audience, which will be made up of federal agency and university researchers, students, and stakeholders from southern Arizona. There will also be a poster session where students and researchers are encouraged to report on completed or in-progress studies.
