

Wildlife Ecology Technician

Wildlife ecology technician is needed immediately for sage grouse project in eastern Oregon. The technician will work closely with scientists in capturing and placing radio collars on sage grouse. The technician will be trained by scientist and graduate students in tracking sage grouse using radio telemetry. After training is complete, the technician will work independently tracking sage grouse. This position will require the technician to work alone and live in remote areas for an extended period of time. In mid to late June the technician will work along with a graduate student conducting vegetation surveys then returning to tracking sage grouse. The position will last into August and potentially into September. Housing and a work truck will be provided. The salary is \$10.44 an hour.
